- Our organization and our routines must apply in accordance with the laws, regulations and certifications which our factory is covered by.
- Develop and deliver products and services of the right and consistent quality according to customers' needs and requirements.
- Deliver products that correspond with agreed design, quality and at the agreed upon time.
- Follow-up with suppliers to ensure they meet set quality and environmental requirements.
- To ensure requirements and demands are met the quality work shall be conducted in such a way as to promote continuous improvements of the business.
- Continuous follow-up and investigation of quality deviation.
- Contribute to a reduction of greenhouse gas emissions by choosing transports with lower environmental impacts, and to minimise the number of transports.
- Strive to be energy efficient in our business and use energy efficient tools.
- Use renewable sources of energy for electricity and heat.
- Reduce rest and waste products from Sepson's own business as well as from suppliers and recycle waste that is created.
- Continuously work for improved and simplified handling of chemicals and waste as well as secure that environmentally hazardous waste is handled in a safe manner, both at Sepson and at our suppliers.
- All coworkers have the right to information, equipment, tools and training to be able to carry out their tasks within the frame of this policy. This right also carries with it an obligation to participate in activities to improve quality and environmental impacts.
